Karen's Walks Committee report below.

Walks reports Nov Dec Jan 2025-2026

Instead of the walks organizers giving a detailed report for next month, I will just give a general summary of the last quarter and an idea of what is to come for the next quarter. All the relevant walks information, maps and updates will be by email.

We had a few changes last quarter due to weather and potential difficulties with river water levels or paddock conditions.

Jim Smith has checked tracks for having all 3 groups walking in the Brook Sanctuary next time.

Highfield scheduled for 13 th November was cancelled due to rain but successfully walked on the 18 th of December. We hope the new managers will allow us to continue walking on this property.

Wangapeka walk didn't go ahead on the 27 th of November but at short notice we were able to slot in Ruby Bay hinterland that day since the weather was not due on the coast until later on. We got wet but most of the walk was acceptable. Wangapeka was not well supported on the 11 th December. It is a long drive but also maybe too close to Christmas.

Rameka crossover only 4 walk 1's who took 2 cars to Rameka. Mark was happy to taxi some walk 2 people to Canaan so everyone made it and had a very enjoyable walk. Walk 3 walked over 11km's along the top of the track. A very good effort. Lots of delays on the road meant the early start was a good call.

Tony's bus trip to Milnthorpe was well supported. Tony has found that school holidays are a good time to plan outings using the community bus. Where to next Tony?

Our new walk On the Maitland track and Red hills had to be postponed twice. I have proposed to put this in the next quarter's program on the 26 th of February in place of Holyoake Clearing and Observation Beach. We may need long daytime hours for this walk and if we don't do it before daylight saving finishes we would have to wait until next daylight saving starts. Most other cancelled walks will otherwise be carried over to the next quarter if suitable.

You should all have received the next quarterly program.

I think Jim has arranged to do a walk 3 recce for the Pearse River. We will need a recce for walk 2

and a leader to come along. Everyone will get wet feet.

April will be an expensive koha month but I feel we need to keep some of these walks on our program to encourage new member's esp. new walk 1 people.

Some of our local walks that do not need land owners permission, I will keep for sudden program changes, wet weather somewhere but it might be ok at home. This may mean some local walks are done without maps. These maps are on our website if you want them. Passwords are available by sending a request to the secretary/co-ordinator who sends the request to our password provider.

We might still need another short walk for 3 walks medley on February 19 if the carpark is still too rough.
